God in man made manifest.



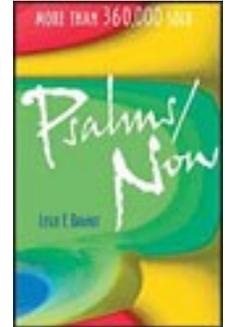
